## Directions to the Venue – Pakistani Muslim Centre (PMC)

**By Car:** From the City, head south on Carver street toward West street. At Carter Square, take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit onto A625/Furnival Gate. Move on until you get to the round about, then take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit onto A621/Arudel Gate, continue to follow A621. At Park Square, take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit onto B6071/Broad Street. Continue onto Cricket Inn road, at the round about, take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit onto Woodbourn road.

**By Rail:** If you come to Sheffield by Train, walk up to Tram line (10 minutes) towards the city centre. Take the Super tram to woodbourn road (usually is advisable to buy a day ticket £3.00) in case you wish to use it on your return journey, the ticket can also be used for all Stage Coach Buses. If you drop at the tram stop at Woodbourn road, just move back and cross over the tramline on your right. Walk back some 30 metres across the Traffic light and walk up some 20 metres, on your right the venue is clearly written PMC.

**By Bus:** If you travel by bus with National Express, your last stop in Sheffield will be the Sheffield Interchange. A member of the Local Organising Committee will be at the Interchange to guide you to the venue. From the Interchange, you may walk towards the city centre and at the Ponds Forge tram station take the Tram that is bound to Meadowhall. Remember you are to drop at the Woodbourn road. Alternatively, if you are up to four to five people, it is advisable to take a Taxi to the venue from the Interchange.

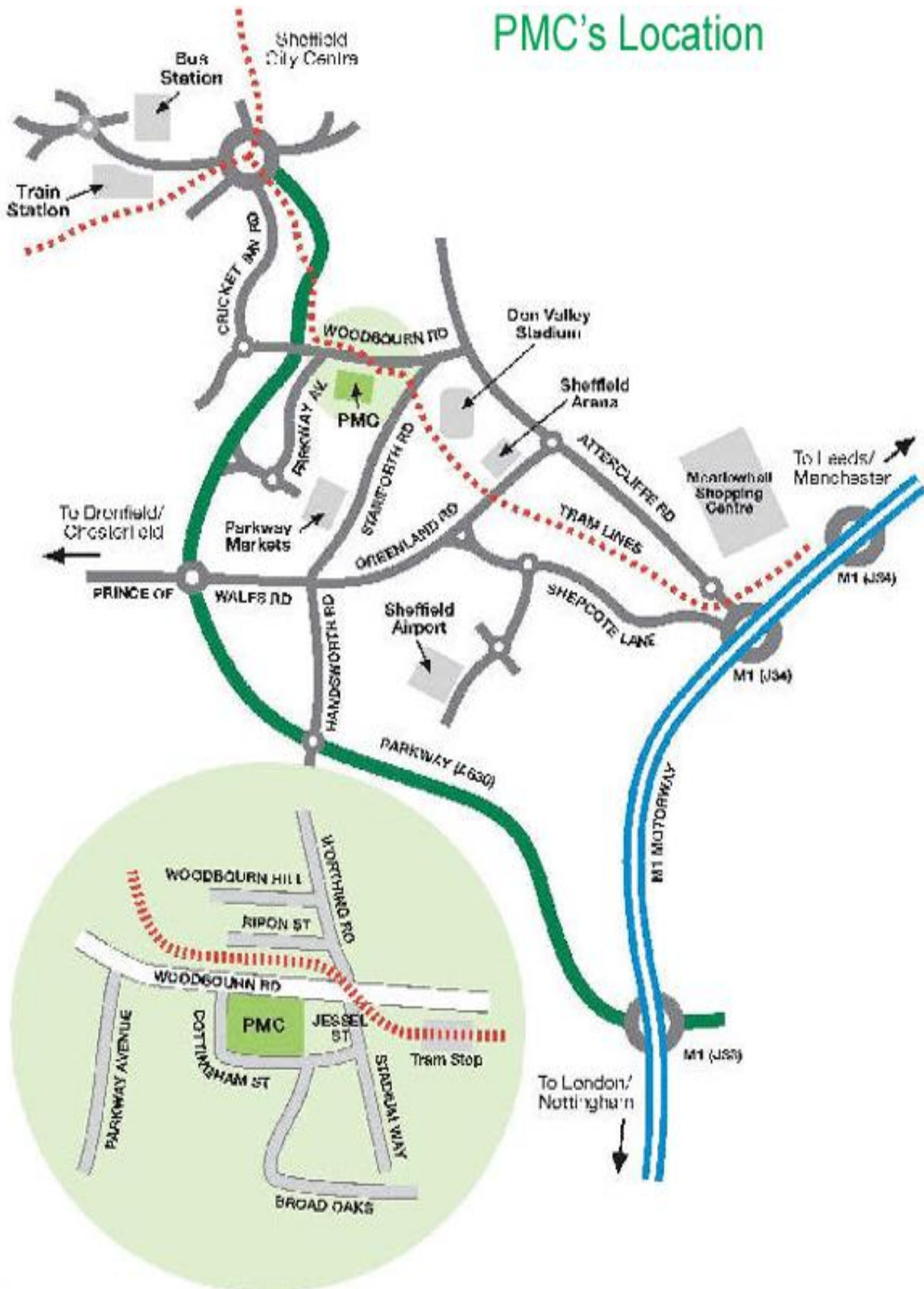
