## By Car

The East London Mosque is easily accessible from all parts of UK. Those travelling from outside London are advised to check maps prior to travelling to determine the best route. A good route planner is provided by the AA ([www.theaa.com](http://www.theaa.com)), or by Google maps (<http://maps.google.co.uk/>), etc. Participants driving to other areas in London (Monday-Friday) are advised to please be aware of the London Congestion Charging (<http://www.cclondon.com/index.shtml>).

## By Rail

The majority of cities and towns in England have excellent rail links with London. Train operators such as Virgin have frequent services that run through stations such as **Euston** and **King's Cross**. For further information on train times and costs visit [www.thetrainline.com](http://www.thetrainline.com). Participants could then make their individual connections to the conference venue, by local bus or through the London Underground.

## By Coach

There is a direct frequent coach service from most UK cities and towns to London. The two main coach services are the National Express and Mega Bus, with the former being the more reliable but expensive option. All Coaches terminate at **Victoria Coach Station** unless stated otherwise. For times and more information on National Coach Services please visit the National Express's website at [www.nationalexpress.co.uk](http://www.nationalexpress.co.uk) or, Mega Bus at ([www.megabus.com](http://www.megabus.com)). Participants could then make their individual connections to the conference venue, by local bus or through the London Underground.

## Local Buses

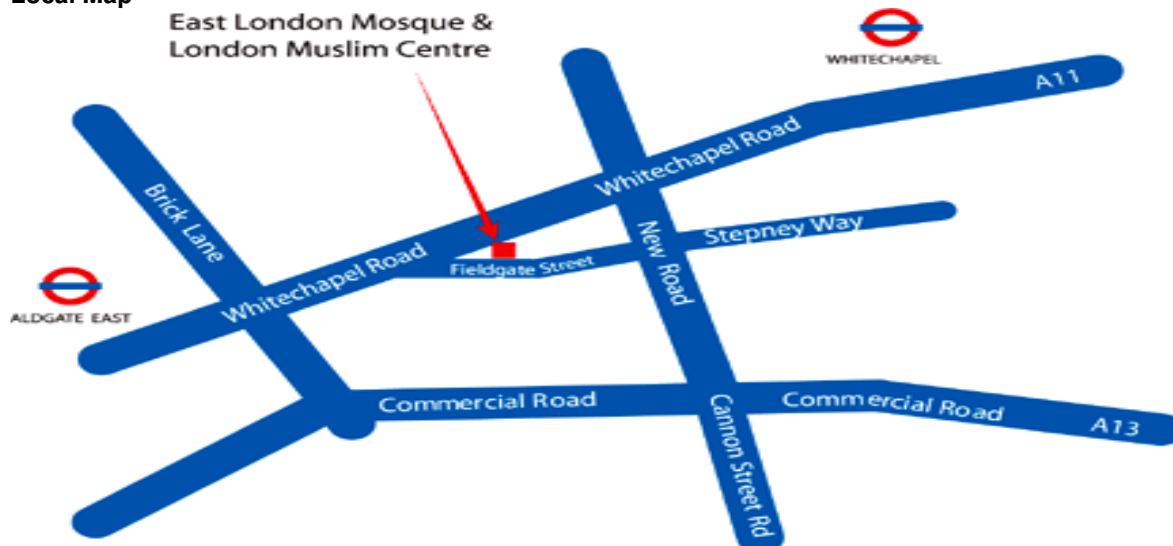
There are 5 local buses that serve **Whitechapel Rd**. These are 25, 254, 15, 115, and the D3. Please check the enclosed local map in order to verify your stop/drop out position.

## London Underground

East London mosque is served by two underground stations **Aldgate east** and **Whitechapel** which are both on the District and the Hammersmith and city lines. From Victoria coach station you can take the District line directly to both stations. From Kings cross station catch the Hammersmith and City line direct to Aldgate East or Whitechapel.
